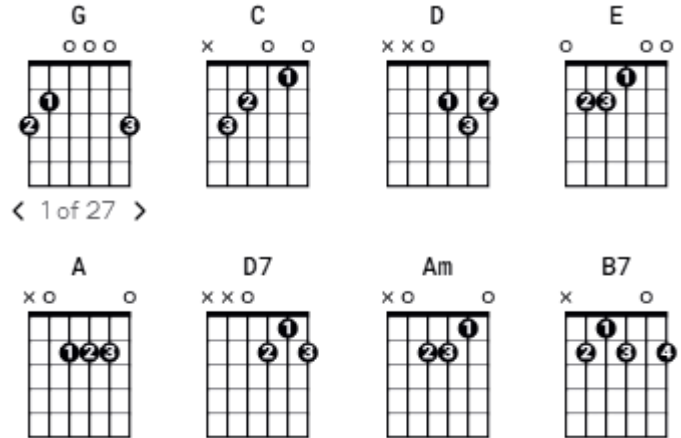


In The Garden
