Luke Chapter 10

38 Now it came to pass, as they went, that he entered into a certain village: and a certain woman named Martha received him into her house.

39 And she had a sister called Mary, which also sat at Jesus' feet, and heard his word.

40 But Martha was cumbered about much serving, and came to him, and said, Lord, dost thou not care that my sister hath left me to serve alone? bid her therefore that she help me.

41 And Jesus answered and said unto her, Martha, Martha, thou art careful and troubled about many things:

42 But one thing is needful: and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her.

1. Busy is OK

Luke 10:38, 40 & 41

- a. Martha was a Proverbs 31 woman
- b. She believed in the OT Resurrection for all

2. Believing is Better

Luke 10:39, 42

- a. It was that One, Most Important One
- b. This is SALVATION & Security

John 10:28 And **I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.** 29 My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand. 30 I and my Father are one.

Titus 3:5 Not by works of righteousness

Ephesians 2:8-9 For by grace are ye saved through faith;

3. Believeest Thou This?

John 11:23 - 27.

- a. Martha went from dishes to disciple
- b. Believeest Thou This?

Romans 3:23 For all have sinned,

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death;

Romans 5:8 while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
